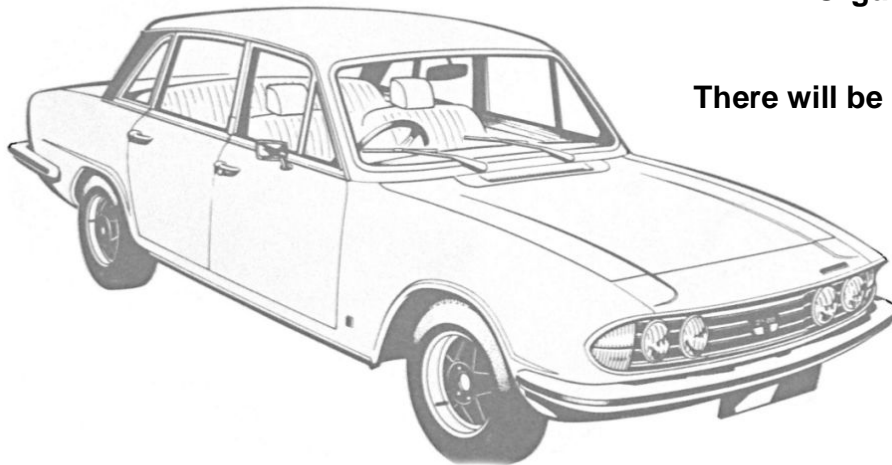
The event plays host to all Standard Triumph cars and derived vehicles.

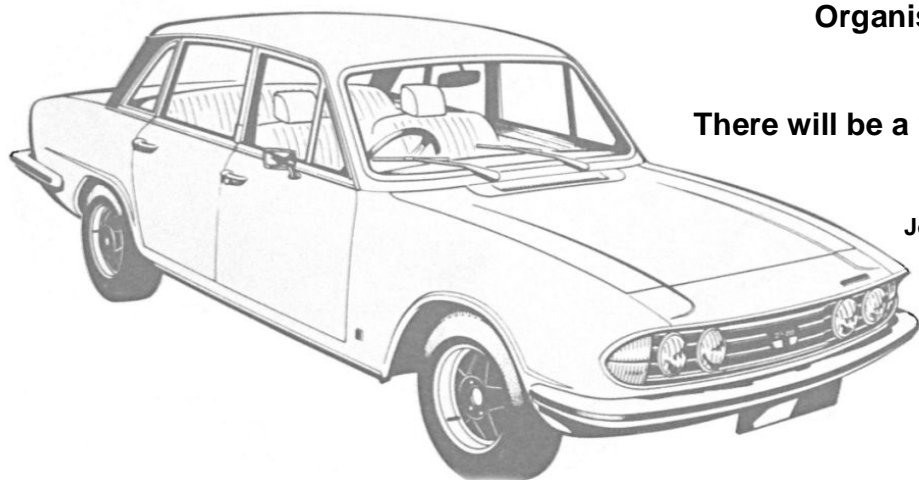
